Yes, we have suffered, yet we are to celebrate the season of light, the season of Hope, Joy, Peace and Love, a season we celebrate what God has done for us hanging on a cross for our sins yet giving us the choice to engage in the Holy of making a little heaven here on earth with each day we have. I have grieved the loss of 10 folks these past 1 ½ years, which has inspired me to engage in the Holy. Their deaths have further moved me in the sanctification process that God is doing to me. I have also seen many of you, too, moved by God to grow in faith, even in years of difficulties. You have ministered to others in your actions, words, and prayers to make beauty here at Ebenezer and in our community. This Body of Christ continues to build on the heritage of this community to provide a house of God for us all to live in the difficulty of life and yet to celebrate the gift of life to all who walk into the doors of this building.

Folks, God is using you to do the work of sanctification. You are engaging in this group of followers of Jesus. God is changing you for the good. You are suffering for good. You are being transformed by God just by engaging in the community of Ebenezer. Your words and actions are being used by God to perpetuate the way of God that saves us all by God sustaining us with time on earth, talents from birth, and resources of materials. We are investing in the stone called Ebenezer. God's foundation is growing in our community that is "church." That is the Easter celebration that continues all our lives.

Folks, engage and see what God has done for you.

#### The Property Committee Report

The committee has met with our new chair, Mike Wertman, to discuss the upgrades, repairs and maintenance needs of the church. With a list of more than 200 items to address, the committee is carefully reviewing Ebenezer's requirements, priorities and budget to make completing these projects possible. First on the docket is the completion of the fellowship hall flooring, replacing the carpet and

linoleum with new, vinyl plank.


#### April 2024




· Build a firefighter-themed splash park at Ontelaunee Park in New Tripoli.
